Case is advanced. Petitioner and Respondent no.2 have filed a joint memo to the effect that matter is settled for Rs.7,85,000/-(Seven lakhs eighty five thousand only).

Perused. Satisfied.

Petitioners are present today.

Respondent no.2 has agreed to deposit the amount of Rs.7,85,000/- before the court within three months.

The joint memo is read over to the parties. They agreed the same. The joint memo is lawful and not opposed to the public policy and duly signed by the parties. Perused identity card. The compensation amount is just and reasonable. Joint memo is accepted. Accordingly I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition is allowed in terms of joint memo.

Respondent no.2 shall deposit the amount of Rs.7,85,000/- before the court within 3 months from this order failing which the settled amount shall carry an interest @ 6% p.a.

The joint memo shall be the part and parcel of the award.

After deposit of the compensation amount, the entire apportioned amount shall be released in favour of petitioner on proper identification and after due verification through E-payment.

Draw award accordingly.
