**Cross Examination by Sri.SVSR Advocate for R2 :**

- 1) It is true to suggest that I have not treated the petitioner. It is true to suggest that I have not seen the case sheet and old X-ray films while assessing the disability of the petitioner. It is true to suggest that I have not taken any opinion from the doctor, who treated the petitioner, while assessing the disability of the petitioner.
- 2) It is true to suggest that what I have stated in para No.5 of my Affidavit are mentioned only on the basis of the say of the petitioner. It is false to suggest that what I have stated in para No.6 of my Affidavit are only my imagination.
- 3) It is true to suggest that all the fractured bones are united. It is false to suggest that what I have stated in para No.8 of my Affidavit are against to the guidelines of the Government. It is false to suggest that I have given false report only with an intention to help the petitioner.
- 4) It is true to suggest that what I have stated is only physical disability. It is false to suggest that the petitioner can do his day-to-day activities without any support. The witness volunteers that “with some difficulty she can do her day-to-

day activities”.

- 5) It is true to suggest that there is no severe restrictions in the lower limb of the petitioner. It is false to suggest that the petitioner can do her tailoring work as she was doing earlier to accident.
- 6) It is false to suggest that without there being any support or materials or without clinically examining the petitioner, I have stated that the petitioner is suffering from disability. It is false to suggest that only with an intention to help the petitioner, I have stated more percentage of disability than the actual disability of the petitioner.
- 7) It is true to suggest that I have not given any estimation about the future medical expenses.
