ORDER

Petition filed under Sec.166 of M.V. Act is allowed with cost.

Petitioners are awarded compensation of **₹32,36,500/-** together with interest @ 6% p.a. from the date of petition till the realization.

Respondent No.1 is liable to pay the compensation as awarded by this Tribunal.

Respondent No.2 - Insurance company shall deposit aforesaid amount within two months from the date of this order and recover the entire compensation amount along with interest from the Respondent No.1 in



view of violation of terms of insurance policy.

After deposit of amount, 50% of the amount is apportioned to 1st Petitioner and 30% is apportioned to the Petitioner No.2 and 10% each is apportioned to the petitioner No.3 and 4.

Out of the said apportioned amount in respect of Petitioner No.1, 25% of the amount shall be kept in FD in her name in any nationalized or scheduled bank for a period of 2 years and balance 75% amount shall be disbursed to her through E-payment on proper identification.

The entire apportioned amount in respect of Petitioner No.2 shall be kept in FD in any nationalized bank of Petitioner No.1's choice till she attains the age of majority and petitioner No.1 is at liberty to draw periodical interest.

The entire apportioned amount in respect of Petitioner No.3 and 4 shall be disbursed to them through E-payment on proper identification.

Advocate's fee is fixed at ₹.1,000/-.
