Chief Examination by Sri.VR Advocate for
Petitioner:

1. Today I have filed my affidavit in lieu of my examination in chief. The contents of the affidavit are true and correct. My Affidavit, filed in lieu of my examination in chief, has been prepared by me.
2. I have produced the original Medico Legal Case register maintained in Aster CMI hospital and the police intimation document and so also produced the certified copies of the said documents.
3. **Note:** A perusal of these original documents and the copies makes it pellucid that by keeping the original documents as yard stick, by mechanical process, these copies have been prepared. Therefore these copies are marked as **Ex.P.21 and P.22** respectively and the original documents are returned to the witness.

6. **Question:** What is the meaning of splenectomy ?

Answer : Whenever spleen of a person is severally damaged, then, the spleen will be removed with surgical intervention, and this procedure is called as splenectomy.

7. **Question :** What are the ill effects of removal of spleen ?

Answer: The main function of spleen is to produce antibodies which protect the human body from infection, and another function of spleen is that it stores and produces both

white blood cells, red blood cells, and platelets. Once the spleen is removed, the ill effect would be, the patient concerned will be prone for repeated infection, which also affects the overall life style of the patient. Besides, the patient concerned may get frequent infections like fever, cold, cough and other infections also.
