Chief Examination by Smt. MGR Advocate for
Petitioner:

1. Today I have filed my affidavit in lieu of my examination in chief. The contents of my affidavit are true and correct. My Affidavit, filed in lieu of my examination in chief, has been prepared by my advocate on my instructions.
2. I have produced the Outpatient record and one X-ray film pertaining to injured person by name Punith. The said documents are marked as **Ex.P14 and Ex.P15 respectively.**

Cross Examination by Sri. GS Advocate for R2 :

3. It is true to suggest that I have not given any treatment to said Punith at any point of time.
4. It is true to suggest that I have not ascertained the functional disability of the petitioner.
5. It is true to suggest that the fractured bone of said Punith has already been united.

6. Now, implants can be removed.
7. It is false to suggest that after the removal of the implants the extent or percentage of disability of the petitioner gets reduced.
8. With some difficulty the petitioner can do his day-to-day routine activities.
9. It is true to suggest that the present petitioner by name Punith has no problem of restriction of movement of shoulder joint.
10. It is false to suggest that Clavicle Bone is only a ornamental bone and the fracture of clavicle bone does not cause any disability and any problem.
11. It is true to suggest that the petitioner can get the removal of implants done in any Government hospital.

12. It is true to suggest that I have not calculated the percentage of problem of petitioner in my affidavit filed in lieu of my examination in chief. The witness volunteers that “I have done the calculation in Ex.P14 only”.
13. It is false to suggest that without any clinical examination of the petitioner I have falsely stated that the petitioner sustained permanent physical impairment.
14. It is false to suggest that the petitioner has not sustained any problems, **yet**, only with an intention to help the petitioner I am deposing false evidence before this court.

Cross examination by R1:

R1 absent. Hence cross examination by R1 is taken as nil.

Re-examination : Nil.
