

PCR 172/2024

Complainant present.

Heard. It is alleged that, the complainant's father and his partner had been running business in the premises of Lakshmi Theater which is owned by accused persons. The complainant's father entrusted the management of business to complainant. The accused canceled the agreement and said to vacate the premises. The complainant's father deposited an amount of Rs.1,06,00,000/- out of which after deducts Rs.11,33,852/- remaining amount has to be returned by accused. They issued chequ, said cheque returned dishonor. Then they called the complainant for payment, When the complainant and his father went to accused house, they threatened and forcibly snatched the cheques. The complainant already vacate the premises. Thereby the accused committed offence punishable u/s. 406, 419, 420, 504, 506(b) r/w. 34 of IPC.

On careful perusal, it is just and necessary to investigate by police. There is allegation of assault, assure etc. It is necessary to collect documentary evidence. Hence, matter is referred to SHO of Suddaguntepalya P.S. for investigation by registering the FIR u/s. 156 of Cr.P.C..

Hence, SHO of Suddaguntepalya P.S. is directed to register the FIR, investigate the matter and submit report.
