

ORDER

The complainant has filed private complaint under section 223 of BNSS, 2023 against the accused No.1 to 5 for the offences punishable under section 316(2), 318(3), 318(4), 322, 61(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and the

complainant sought to refer the matter to the Sanjaynagar Police Station for investigation under section 175(3) of BNSS, 2023.

2. Perused the complaint and heard advocate for complainant.

3. As per section 175(3) of BNSS, 2023 called submissions from the concerned jurisdictional SHO/PSI and the jurisdictional DCP with regard to the non registration of the complaint filed by the complaint on 05.11.2025 vide its order dated 13.01.2026.

4. The PSI of Sanjaynagar Police Station submitted his report stating that the dispute between the complainant and accused persons is related to civil in nature and informed them to approach competent civil court.

5. On perusal of the complaint averments, submission report and materials available on record cognizable and non bailable offences are disclosed. Though the complainant has lodged a complaint before the Sanjaynagar Police Station but they have not been taken any action. The complainant has also complained the same to the superior

officer of the Police, but no action has been taken. The complaint is supported with a affidavit sworn to by the complainant. The court feels that this is a fit case to refer the matter for investigation.

ORDER

Acting under section 175(3) of BNSS, 2023 the case is referred to the PSI/SHO of Sanjaynagar Police Station with a direction to register the FIR, investigate the matter and submit his report as early as possible.

Issue directions accordingly.

Await final report by 30.09.2026.
