ORDERS

The Police Inspector of J.P.Nagar Police Station has filed charge sheet against the accused for the offences punishable under Sections 380 and 454 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accused was released on bail on 09.04.2002 by executing surety.

After publication of Proclamation and warrant for attachment of the properties of the accused, it was informed by the Police Inspector of J.P.Nagar Police Station that there are no properties standing in the name of the accused for attachment. The provisions of Sections 81 and 82 of Cr.P.C. is complied.

This Court has examined PW1 and got marked Ex.P1 Proclamation. The other Prosecution witnesses are given up by the Prosecution at this stage.

It appears that there are no chances of securing the accused in the near future. Hence, the entire record is submitted to the Hon'ble Principal District and Session

Court Bengaluru for kind permission to transfer this case from Register No.III to Long Pending Cases Register.

Office is directed to submit the entire record to the Hon'ble Principal District and Session Court, Bengaluru.

Since the accused is absconding after enlarging on bail. Hence, his bail bond executed by the surety is forfeited and Office is hereby directed to register a criminal case against the surety and issue intimation to the concerned authority to recover the said forfeited amount from the property of the surety and report to this Court.
