

ORDER

The Complainant has filed this complaint under section 223 of BNSS Act, 2023 against the accused persons for their alleged commission of offences punishable under section 318, 338, 324, 335, 316, 3(5), 61 of BNS-2023.

2. Heard the arguments from the complainant side and perused the materials on record.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case this Court is of the opinion that it is not necessary to refer the case to the Police for investigation. If any required to collect evidence by Police, the complainant can collect as per section 225 of BNSS Act, 2023. It is necessary to give an opportunity to the complainant to

prove his case. There is no sufficient materials to take cognizance at this stage if complainant able to produce documents to attract above offences and proceed the case then it can be proceeded. Hence, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The complainant is permitted to prove his case of examining himself and other witnesses.
