ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.13(3) of Birth and Death Registration Act, 1969 seeking direction to the respondent to record date of birth of the petitioner.

2. **BRIEF FACTS:-**

The petitioner submits that, he was born on 24.09.1979. However due to ignorance parents of the petitioner have not

complied with the registration the birth of the petitioner. The petitioner is in need of his birth certificate. Hence this petition.

3. Notice to the respondent, which is duly served. In spite of due service of notice, respondent has remained absent. Hence, respondent is placed exparte.

4. The petitioner is examined as P.W.1 and got marked Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.3.

5. Heard the arguments, perused materials placed on record.

6. The following points would arise for my determination:-

1. Whether the petitioner has placed sufficient materials on record to establish that, he was born on 24.09.1979?
 2. What order?
7. My findings on the above points as under:

REASONS

8. **Point No.1:-** The petitioner contended in his affidavit that he was born on 24.09.1979. However due to

ignorance of the parents of petitioner have not complied with the registration of his date of birth. The petitioner is in need of his birth certificate. Hence this petition. The petitioner has produced the Non Availability Certificate issued by the respondent which is at Ex.P.1 and to substantiate his date of birth and he has produced the Adhar Card which is at Ex.P.2 and Pan Card which is at Ex.P.3 respectively.

9. The affidavit and documentary produced by the petitioner has gone unchallenged as the respondent has remained absent. On considering the affidavit as well as documents on record, I am of the view that petitioner has established that, he was born on 24.09.1979 at No.93, Fayazabad, Kanakanagar, Yelachenahalli, Bengaluru South, Bengaluru - 560 078. Therefore in order to do substantial justice, the date of birth of the petitioner is required to be registered by the registering authority. Hence, I answer point No.1 in the **AFFIRMATIVE**.

10. **Point No.2:** For the foregoing reasons, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

The petition is **ALLOWED**.

The respondent is directed to cause an entry of date of birth of the petitioner by name **MUNNA** was born on **24.09.1979** in the Register of Birth and Death on payment of prescribed fee and issue birth certificate to the petitioner in accordance to law.
