ORDER

This petition filed U/s.13(3) of Birth and Death Registration Act, 1969 seeking direction to the respondent to record date of death of deceased Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah.

2. **BRIEF FACTS:-**

The petitioner's submit that, deceased Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah is father of petitioner's No.1 to 3 who has died on 29.04.2006. However due to ignorance of the petitioner's have not complied with the registration of the death of Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah. The petitioner's are in need of their father death certificate. Hence this petition.

3. Notice to the respondent, which is duly served. In spite of due service of notice, respondent has remained absent. Hence, respondent is placed exparte.

4. The petitioner is examined as P.W.1 and got marked Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.5.

5. Heard the arguments. Perused materials placed on record.

6. The following points would arise for my determination:-

1. Whether the petitioner's have placed sufficient materials on record to establish that their father Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah has died on 29.04.2006 ?

2. What order?

7. My findings on the above points as under:

Point No.1 - In the Affirmative

Point No.2 - As per final orders for the following:

REASONS

8. **Point No.1:-** PW.1 submits that his father Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah has died on 29.04.2006. However due to ignorance his date of death is not recorded in the register of death. PW.1 is in need of his father death certificate. PW.1 has produced Non-availability certificate issued by the respondent which is marked at Ex.P.1, Two paper (Hosa Diganta and Business Standard) publications on 09.03.2026 which are marked at Ex.P.2 and Ex.P.3, Family Tree Affidavit which is marked at Ex.P.4 and three Aadhar cards which are marked at Ex.P.5.

9. The oral and documentary evidence tendered by PW.1 has gone unchallenged as the respondent has remained

absent. On considering the evidence on record, I am of the view that PW.1 has established that his father Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah has died on 29.04.2006. However due to inadvertence the death of deceased Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah is not recorded in the Register of Deaths. Therefore in order to do substantial justice, the date of death of the deceased Puttaiah @ Puttaiah Narasaiah is required to be registered. Hence, I answer point No.1 in the **AFFIRMATIVE**.

10. **Point No.2:** For the foregoing reasons, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition is **ALLOWED**.

The Respondent is directed to cause an entry of date of death of **PUTTAIAH @ PUTTAIAH NARASIAH** who has died on **29.04.2006**, in the Register of Birth and Death on payment of prescribed fee and issue death certificate to the petitioner in accordance to law.
