

05-08-2026ORDERS ON B-REPORT

The complainant filed a private complaint against the accused persons for the offences punishable under Sections 107, 109, 120B, 378, 379, 380, 405, 406, 415, 417, 418, 503, 504 and 506 r/w. 34 of IPC. The court referred the matter for investigation to the Rajarajeshwarinagara Police Station. Police filed B-report. Complainant filed objection challenging the B-report.

2. PSI of Rajarajeshwarinagara Police Station filed B-report stating that the complainant failed to produce any documentary proof regarding valuable items taken away by the accused persons, there are no proof regarding except accused No.1 the rest of the accused persons are staying in Bengaluru, call details shown that the accused persons are living in different places than Bengaluru, accused No.5 is an Govt. Employee whose signature is found on the date of incident in the attendance register, complainant failed produce any documentary proof regarding when the misunderstanding arose between husband and wife the complainant along with her children shifted to Shivamoga.

3. The complainant filed objection contending that the police have not conducted investigation properly, veracity of the

documents produced by the complainant has not been tested, it is his allegation that accused persons taken away all the house hold items and valuables from his house to the house at Shivamoga but police have not visited Shivamoga to investigate about the items. The complainant is ready to produce sworn statement.

4. Heard.

5. Gold purchase bill of Vijayalakshmi Jewellery works, Lalith Jewellery Mart Pvt Ltd, Ganesh Jewellers, Topco Zamzam Jewellery are standing in the name of complainant. The Investigating Officer never recorded any finding with regard to the aforementioned gold purchase bill in the B-report. Objection filed by the complainant itself indicates that accused persons taken away all the house hold items and valuables from Bengaluru house to the house at Shivamoga but police have not visited Shivamoga to investigate about the items. Such a process shall be carried out by the Investigating Officer. B-report does not contain any such investigation traveling to Shivamoga. Under such circumstances, it is very much essential to refer the case for further investigation of the case. In view of the above, B-report filed by the Investigating Officer is not proper. Hence, I pass the following:

The B-report submitted by the Police Sub-Inspector of Rajarajeshwarinagara Police Station is rejected.

Matter referred for investigation to the SHO of Rajarajeshwarinagara Police Station.
