

The accused allegedly had subscriber two chits for a sum of Rs.2 lakhs each and paying subscription of Rs.20,000/- per month. The chits were the completed on 22.10.2019. When the complainant demanded for the chit amount to the accused No.1, she requested her, the accused No.2 is in need of money to purchase a house property and asked the complainant to help the accused No.2. The accused No.1 upon the consent of complainant handed over Rs.4 lakhs to the accused No.2. The accused No.2 did never bother to repay the money. When the complainant demanded the accused No.1 and 2 to repay the money they quarreled with the complainant, abused her with filthy words and threats to the life etc.

2. According to the complainant, the accused No.1 and 2 have committed the offences punishable under section 406, 415, 420, 120B read with section 34 of IPC. Without the aid and assistance of the Police the complainant cannot present her case effectively. For the foregoing reasons the court proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

Acting under section 156(3) of Cr.PC the case is referred to the PSI/SHO of Rajajinagar Police Station to investigate the matter and submits the report.

Issue directions accordingly.

Await final report by 20.11.2023.
