If the accused fails to pay the said amount the complaint is liberty to re-open the case from the stage which it is closed and proceeding accordance with law.

I have enquired the accused he has submitted no objections to accept the terms and conditions mentioned in the application. Accordingly application filed U/s 147 of N.I Act is accepted and Case is disposed in accordance with
