

Case called out before lokadalath.
CW-1 is present. Accused
absconded. CW-1 is agreed to
compound the offences.

Accordingly, complainant/ CW-1
and accused has filed application
under section 320(2) of Cr.P.C
and 320(8) of Cr.P.C.

Heard, both sides.

CW-1 has agreed to compound
the offence punishable under
section 406 and 420 of I.P.C.
against the accused.

The offence punishable under
section 406 and 420 of I.P.C. are
compoundable by victim with

permission of the court. The CW-1 is agreed to compound the offences. Hence, court can be permitted him to compound the offences. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The application filed under section 320(2) of Cr.P.C. is hereby allowed. CW-1 is hereby permitted to compound the offences under section 406 and 420 I.P.C. The application filed under section 320(8) of Cr.P.C. is hereby allowed.

Accused is acquitted for the offence punishable under section 406 and 420 of I.P.C. The bail bond of accused is stand cancelled and cash surety of Rs.8,000/- is forfeited. He is set at liberty.
