Examination in Chief by Sr. APP:

On 31.05.2016 I was deputed to Jalahalli PS on OOD from Yashwanthapur PS. On said day CW56 informed me to come near Sapthagiri College at 11.30 a.m. by a phone call. At about 7.15 p.m. I received a phone call of a relative from a native place that an accident has taken place. Accordingly I went to SHO of our PS for seeking leave on said day. At about 7.50 p.m. I received a wireless message that an accident has taken place near Ganapathi Temple. Immediately I went to said spot alongwith SHO. Thereafter we came near Sapthagiri Hospital to see deceased victim and two injured victims. At 8.20 p.m. when we came near Sapthagiri College junction, we found that a van was set on fire by somebody. Thereafter we came to Ganapthinagar and we found that another car was set on fire in said area. Thereafter we came to NRR hospital to see the culprit of said hospital by name Md. Ahmed Ismail. We shifted him to KC General Hospital for further treatment asper advice of concerned doctor. I can identify said culprit of accident.

**Cross Examination by BSG Advocate for accused nos.
1 to 5, 7, 8 and 10 :-**

I was on OOD duty for three years. On 31.05.2016 I was asked to come near Sapthagiri Circle at 11.00 a.m. It is false to suggest that on said day I was not on duty. Other staff members were already on duty at relevant place. I cannot say the number of VaganR Car, which was set on fire near Ganapathi Gudi. Md. Ismail had sustained bleeding injuries. It is false to suggest that though I do not know anything about this case I am deposing falsely as per instance of superiors.
