

14-02-2025ORDERS ON B-REPORT

The complainant has filed complaint against the accused and pleaded for taking cognizance of the offences punishable under Sections 425, 417, 406, 420 and 506 of IPC alleged to have been committed by the accused persons.

After receipt of the complaint, the matter is referred to investigation to the police under Section 156(3) of Cr. P.C., after investigation the Police Sub-Inspector, Girinagar Police Station has submitted B-report, after service of notice to the complainant, the complainant has appeared through his counsel and filed protest petition to the B-report.

Heard, counsel for the complainant on protest petition and B-report.

The Police Sub-Inspector after investigation, he has submitted B-report and it is submitted in the B-report that, on investigation no satisfactory material was available to disclose the accused person has committed the alleged offences and it is also observed that, the dispute is civil in nature and the complainant failed to produce the necessary documents and secure the witnesses and lack of evidence submitted B-report.

On reading of complaint averments it discloses commission of alleged criminal offences, the B-report is filed only on the ground that, no satisfactory evidence available to

file charge sheet and also submitted that, the complainant has failed to produce the documents and secure the witnesses. However, the said evidence can be produced in the course of trial and it is for the complainant to adduce evidence and produce materials in support of allegations made in the complaint.

The complainant has also produced documents in this case in order to show material in support of the allegations made in the complaint. Even though it is stated that, the dispute is civil in nature, the allegation made in the complaint disclose commission of criminal offence. Hence, at this stage it is just and proper to reject the B-report and give permission to complainant to adduce evidence. Accordingly, I pass the following:

The B-report submitted by the Girinagar Police Station is hereby rejected.
