

29-04-2026**ORDERS ON B-REPORT**

Complainant filed a private complaint against the accused persons for the offences punishable under Sections 316, 318, 351 and 352 of BNS. Court referred the matter for investigation to the Chennammanakere Achukattu Police Station. Police filed B-report. Complainant filed objection challenging the B-report.

2. PSI of Chennammanakere Achukattu Police Station filed B-report stating that complainant failed to produce any proof upon service of the police notices, there are no information about consultancy run by complainant and accused, complainant failed to produce any proof regarding candidates demanding salary, a financial transaction took place between the complainant and accused, when the complainant furnished phone numbers he contacted those persons over phone call, they said that the amount was paid to the complainant and the accused persons are not known to them. A person by name Gururaj said that he gave money to Amarnath. In turn, he paid the money to complainant but he does not know the accused persons. As such, he filed this report considering the fact that there are lack of evidence to demonstrate the allegations made against the accused persons.

3. The complainant filed protest petition contending that complainant approached the Investigating Officer as and when

called upon to render co-operation for the investigation, complainant produced all the relevant documents before the Investigating Officer, Investigating Officer did not properly consider the document report, acknowledgment of financial transaction took place between the complainant and accused itself suggest that transaction took place between the parties.

4. Heard.

5. According to the facts of the case, complainant was running a consultancy, she was providing candidates according to the requirements of the complainant, she sent two-three candidates to Sai Ram company on demand, it was noticed that company was not registered, so, she stopped sending the candidates to Sai Ram Company, later on accused persons contacted the company over phone call by taking phone numbers from the Sai Ram company, accused persons requested to send the candidates to their RTS company, she sent 15 candidates to RTS company, thereafter, she came to know that RTS company was closed, she made all attempt to get the salaries of the candidates, the accused persons demanded Rs.80,000/- from complainant to pay the salaries of the candidates, when she made repeated demand for make payment the accused persons threatened the complainant.

6. Investigating Officer filed summary of the B-report before the court. Report filed by the Investigating Officer nowhere

demonstrate that he has made an attempt to collect the evidence relates to the complaint. Investigating Officer mainly relied upon the statements of the accused persons to draw a conclusion that no case made out. Statement of the Gururaj has not been made as part and parcel of his report. It is the clear cut observations of the Investigating Officer that there was a financial transaction between the complainant and accused. It presupposes that there was a hint that financial transaction took place between the complainant and accused. Such being the position, the Investigating Officer ought to have made through investigation about the transaction took place between the complainant and accused. Investigating Officer said that the complainant is willing to file a separate complaint regarding criminal intimidation against the accused No.3 and a further statement was recorded in this regard. Such further statement also not made as part and parcel of the report. It is the say of the complainant that all the documents were produced before the Investigating Officer but he has not properly considered it. Nothing is discussed about the complainant documents in the report. As such, B-report filed by the Investigating Officer is not proper. Hence, I pass the following:

The B-report submitted by the PSI of Chennammanakere Achukattu Police Station is rejected.

Case is referred for further investigation to the ACP, V.V.Puram, Bengaluru.
