EXAMINATION IN CHIEF BY SR. APP:

Since 2016 February to November 2016, I have worked as Chief manager in Indian Overseas Bank. Accused no.2 was working as appraiser in our bank. He was entrusted with the work of appraising of jewels and certifying the quality and genuiness of the jewels. During my tenure there was an inspection conducted by our regional office. During that time it was found that one packet containing jewels are found to be fake jewels. Accused no.1 had pledged the said jewels in the bank. Accused no.2 was the appraiser and he had given genuiness certificate of the said jewels pledged by accused no.1. The bank had granted Rs.1,46,000/- loan to accused no.1 on the basis of certificate issued by accused no.2. The

said fake jewels were weighing 95.80 grams. After we came to know about the fraud, we gave a complaint to the Bommanahalli PS. The witness identifies complaint and is marked as Ex.P.2 and signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P.2(a). Witness identifies the certified copy of account opening form of accused no.1.

At this stage, further chief examination is deferred for producing original documents.
