

EX-PARTE INTERIM ORDERS ON IA NO.1

I.A. No.1 filed by the petitioners U/Sec.23 R/w Sec.18, 19, 20 and 22 of PWDV Act seeking protection order, interim maintenance.

2. In the affidavit accompanying the application petitioner No.1 has contended that, she is legally wedded wife of the respondent No.1 and from the wed lock they have one son i.e., petitioner No.2 herein. It is alleged that, respondent No.1 has subjected her continuous physical assault amounting to physical abuse, repeated humiliation, verbal insults, pressure to give birth to a male child, threats, emotional manipulation, interference in the marital relationship and deliberate attempts to cause mental distress amount to verbal and emotional abuse. She apprehend commission of the acts of domestic violence by the respondent. The acts of the respondents have caused severe physical pain, mental trauma, emotional insecurity and financial hardship to her and have also endangered the safety and well being of the minor child. Hence, this application.

3. Heard and perused the materials available on record.

4. In order to get relief the petitioner No.1 has to make out a prima facie case. In support of her contention she has produced her marriage certificate, marriage photos, copy of the complaint dated 07.03.2026 etc., On perusal of materials available on record, affidavit of the petitioner, prima facie it appears that the respondent No.1 is the husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2 and she has been subjected

to domestic violence at the hands of the respondent No.1. From the affidavit of the petitioner No.1 it is clear that the petitioner No.1 is not working and her child i.e., petitioner No.2 is in the care and custody of petitioner No.1. It is alleged that, the respondent No.1 is subjecting the petitioner to mental and physical torture. The respondent is having income of Rs.50,000/- per month from stocks and trades, fixed deposits. Although, these allegations require to be proved by the petitioner it is prima facie clear that the respondent has neglected petitioner in spite of having sufficient income.

5. Petitioner No.1 also claimed for restraining the respondents or any of their relatives from entering any portion of the shared household in which the petitioner resides. residence order. Petitioner has submitted that, after child birth respondents have attempted forcibly to take away the infant child. Petitioner in support of her contention has produced copy of complaint dated 07.03.2026 wherein she has alleged that respondent No.1 has attempted to forcibly take away petitioner No.2.

6. Under these circumstances this court is of the view that the petitioner has made out prima facie case of domestic violence against the respondents and the main object of this enactment is to provide social justice to the women and children. Hence, this Court proceeds to pass the following :

ORDER

The respondent No.1 is hereby
directed to pay maintenance of

Rs.5,000/- per month to petitioner No.2 from the date of petition till filing objection by respondent.

Further, respondents are hereby directed not to commit any act which amounts to domestic violence and aid or abet any acts of domestic violence against the petitioner.

Further, respondents are hereby restrained from entering any portion of the shared household in which petitioners reside i.e., Adi's North Lake, Apartment No.211, Agrahara, Old Town, Yelahanka, Bengaluru – 560 064.

This exparte interim order will be in force till filing objection to main petition and IA by respondents.

Issue notice to respondents on main petition and IAs through CDPO and speed post, if PF is paid and call for DIR.

The jurisdictional police is hereby directed to give protection to the petitioners if they approach the police.

Issue copy of the order to jurisdictional police station to enable

them to render protection to petitioners if they approach them.

Office is hereby directed to issue free copy of this order along with the notice to respondent.
