The accounts now submitted in evidence for the defendant has been prepared by me. There cannot be any document with the defendant for the money i.e., collected by the plaintiff directly from the chemist. The first business transaction with the plaintiff in January 2017. The credit note has to be issued by the plaintiff to the defendant. The amount is paid by the defendant to the stockist. The same is required to be paid or reimbursed by the plaintiff as per the agreement. Page 30 of Ex.D.7 is the first credit note dated 07.01.2017. The invoices and credit notes were all sent to the plaintiff. It is false to suggest that the credit notes and invoices produced today are false and fabricated after filing of this suit.
