FURTHER CROSS-EXAMINATION BY SRI.MGR ADVOCATE FOR PLAINTIFF.

8. I have stated in my evidence for having lost 3 cheques, witness says has to ask the Secretary. We lodged complaint for having lost cheques before the Tumukur Town Police station. I have not produced any documents to that effect. Now I see Ex.P.5 certified copy of cheque – the account number mentioned in the cheque belongs to defendant No.1 society. Witness says that, only Secretary knows. Defendant No.1 society having two accounts one with Pashwanatha Bank and another with DCC Bank. I have not produced copy of statement of account or passbook before this Court. I cannot produce the same.

9. It is not true to suggest that, defendant No.1 Society is also having account with Axis Bank. It is not true to suggest that, as per Ex.P.3 statement of account Rs.80,00,000/- transferred from SBI to Axis Bank account belongs to defendant No.1. It is not true to suggest that, though I have issued Ex.P.5 cheque in question but discharge of debt but deposing falsely.

10. In my affidavit evidence I have denied the transaction said to have taken place with the plaintiff. Ex.D.1 is the reply

given by DR as to no online transaction in our society. The said reply was given by the office of DR to one Lingaraju one of the members of our society. It is not true to suggest that, one can transfer amount through online to our society. It is false to say that, I have created Ex.D.1 to Ex.D.3 and produced before this Court and deposing falsely.
