ORDERS ON I.A.No.VI

This application U/O.3 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC, filed by defendant No.2 seeking permission to appoint his son as Power of Attorney to prosecute the case.

In the affidavit, it is stated that due to old age, defendant No.2 is not in a position to conduct the case and he has executed Power of Attorney in favour of his son and he may be permitted to represent him.

The plaintiff has not filed any objection to this application.

Since the plaintiff has no objection, the Power of Attorney executed in the name of his son, the application can be allowed and defendant No.2 can be permitted to represent the case through his Power of Attorney Holder. Accordingly, I.A.No.VI U/O.3 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC is allowed. Defendant No.2 is permitted to be represent through his Power of Attorney Holder.
