ORDER

Joint Compromise petition U/O 23 Rule 3 of CPC filed by both parties is hereby allowed.

Suit of the plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of joint compromise petition.

The joint compromise petition shall form part of decree.

Draw final decree accordingly.
