

L/C for the petitioners has filed application U/Sec.32 rule 7 of CPC seeking to appoint the petitioner No.1 as the guardian and he has also produced certificate in this regard and accordingly, in the interest of justice, application is allowed and the petitioner No.1 is appointed as minor guardian to the petitioner No.2 and 3 and petitioner No.1 is permitted to compromise the matter on behalf of the petitioner No.2 and 3.

Both parties are conciliated. Both parties have filed joint memo agreeing to settle the claim as per joint memo. The petitioner has agreed to receive the compensation of Rs. 27,00,000/- as full and final settlement. The respondent no.2 has also agreed to pay the said amount. Accordingly, both parties have filed joint memo and accordingly, I hereby pass the following .

ORDER

The joint memo is hereby allowed.

Petition is hereby allowed and the joint memo filed by the petitioner and the Respondent no.2 is hereby accepted as per the

contents of the joint memo.

The Respondent no.2 is hereby directed to deposit the compensation of Rs.27,00,000/- in the court within 2 months from the date of the award and failing which the said amount shall carry an interest at the rate of 6% from the date of the award.

The petitioner No.1 is entitled 60% of the compensation amount.

The petitioner No.2 and 3 are entitled 20% each of the compensation amount and office is hereby directed to keep the 40% of the compensation amount in the nationalized bank as FD in the names of the petitioner No.2 and 3.

Draw award accordingly.
