

Case called out.

**Exparte T.I. order on I.A.No.I**

Heard Shri. BSK Adv for the plaintiff. Perused the plaint, I.A.No.I, affidavit averments and also documents.

This is suit for partition and separate possession. The case of the plaintiff is that the plaintiff and defendants constitute members of the Hindu undivided joint family and the suit schedule properties are their ancestral properties. The plaintiff is having her legitimate share in the suit schedule properties. The defendants having colluded with each other and taking undue advantage of the names of defendant no.1 and D9 to D11 appearing in the RTC extracts of the suit schedule properties are hurriedly trying to alienate the suit schedule properties in order to deprive the plaintiff of her legitimate share in the suit schedule properties.

The learned counsel for the plaintiff further submits that if notice is issued to the other side, the delay would defeat the very purpose of filing of I.A.No.I.

Satisfied. In view of urgency notice on I.A.No.I to the defendants no.1 and D9 to D11 U/order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C. is dispensed with.

Ex-parte T.I. order is granted restraining the defendants no.1 and D9 to D11 from alienating the suit schedule properties, to any third person in any manner, till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the requisites of Order 39 R.3 (A) and (B) of CPC by tomorrow.

Issue S/S to defendants amongst to them also issue notice on I.A.No.I and T.I. warrant to the defendants no.1 and D9 to D11 through RLAD, if P.F. and postal charges are paid, r/by 28/07/2023 .
