That from 12.8.2016 to 12.11.2016 in the land of CW-41, R.S.No.66, at 9.00 a.m., you all the accused No.1 to 4 inspite of knowing that the victims CW-6 to 36 belong to Schedule caste, brought the victims from Telangal state, Nagarkarnool district, Achchampet Mandal, Malmooru Mandal, Uppuntala Mandal, to Chinchani village, Chikkodi Taluk, Dist: Belagavi and on behalf of B.V.R.Company, for Nippani-Mudhol road work, and told them to give advance and taken bond from them and taken their signatures on promisory notice and told them to give more than Rs.3,500/- every month and not given salary to them, and taken work from them and put huts in the land of one Pandurang Appajigol and kept them in the hut and confined them in the said ut and took them to work in their vehicle only and gave morning meals in the hut only and gave afternoon lunch in the plce of work and taken work from them from 8.00 a.m., to 19.00 hours., and if they absent one day, not paid the wage to them and not taken care of their health and given less money and taken work for more hours and treated them

as slave and compels them to labours against the will of that persons and thereby you have committed the offences punishable u/s. 370(20(3), 374, 342 of IPC and Sec. 16,17 and 18 of Bonded Labour Act, 1976 and Se.c. 3(1)(h) of SC/ST PA Act, 1989, within my cognizance.

And I hereby direct that you be tried on the set charge.
