

IA No. 12/2025 in SC No. 648/2023
State Vs. Sunny & Ors.

This is an application under Section 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of the accused / applicant namely Geetansh @ Abhi Pagla.

Present: Sh. Girish Giri, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused / applicant.

IO SI Deepak Kumar is present.

1. Briefly stated that on 06.06.2023 at about 12.10 a.m., the injured alongwith his friend Sachin and Keshar @ DJ were going towards BJRM hospital, Jahangir Puri, Delhi from Prayas, Boys Shelter Home to take rickshaw. When he reached in front of 500 wali gali, E Block Sunday Bazaar Road, Jahangir Puri, Delhi, three boys namely Sunny (pani wala) R/o E block, Jahangir Puri, Delhi, Abhi @ Pagla and one unknown boy came from the BJRM hospital side on an unknown motorcycle. It has been further stated that those boys stopped the motorcycle in front of him and came down from motorcycle. Sunny and that unknown boy caught hold of him and Abhi @ Pagla took out a dagger(knife) from the pant. It has been stated further that Sunny then said that *“Maar sale ko chaku khatam karde isko”*, on which, Abhi @ Pagla with intention to kill him attacked him with the dagger (knife). He somehow pushed Sunny and Abhi @ Pagla and ran towards fields of EE Block Jahangir Puri, Delhi where he had made a PCR call from his mobile phone.

2. It was argued by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that the applicant/accused is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It was further submitted that applicant/accused is in JC since 07.06.2023 and all the co-accused persons have already granted bail. It was argued by the Ld. Counsel for the accused / applicant that the accused / applicant has no criminal antecedent. It was argued by the Ld. Counsel for the accused / applicant that nothing was recovered from the possession of the applicant / accused. It was argued further that the investigation has already been completed. It was further argued that the trial has not commenced as yet and it would take long time to conclude the trial. It is submitted that no purpose would be served to keep the accused in custody. That accused is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions. It is prayed that a lenient view be taken.

3. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has vehemently opposed the bail application and argued that allegations against the applicant / accused are serious and grave in nature. It has been further argued by the Ld. Additional PP for the State that matter is at the initial stage and charge yet to be framed. All the public witnesses / material witnesses are yet to be examined, hence, prayer is made for dismissal of the bail application.

4. I have heard the Ld. Addl. PP for State and Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

5. Matter is at the initial stage. Charge is yet to be framed. Out of 16 witnesses, not even a single witness has been examined as yet. All the material/public witnesses are yet to be examined. As

per report of IO, weapon of offence i.e. dagger (knife) was recovered at the instance of the accused / applicant. Moreover, the allegations against accused / applicant are of grave and serious in nature. Clear role has been attributed to the applicant / accused. There is every possibility that if released on bail he may commit similar offence or influence or threaten the witnesses.

6. Seeing the totality of the fact and circumstances and the above said discussion, no ground for grant of bail is made out at this stage. **Accordingly, the bail application of applicant/accused stands dismissed.**

Application stands disposed off.

7. *It is clarified that nothing stated herein shall tantamount to an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.*

8. Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused as well as be sent to concerned IO, concerned Jail Superintendent, Ld. Secretary, DLSA (North), through all possible modes, as per rules.
