Chief Examination by Learned Public Prosecutor:

1. I am a BHMS graduate. I have a clinic named Shri. Guru Dattatreya at Anjaneya Nagar. I am practicing medicine since 25 years. Since I am practice period I am a family doctor to the late Santosh Padmannavar.

2. On 09.10.2024 at 09.00 pm when I was in my clinic it is Cw-26 came and informed be that his uncle Santosh Padmannvar fell unconscious thus he asked me to visit his house for medical examination. Accordingly I by taking stethoscope and BP machine went his in car to Mr. Santosh Padmannavar's residence. Accordingly they took the for the bed room of Santosh Padmannvar where his body was lying

on the cot, I examined his pulse eye reflexes but there was no pulse beat and even there was no reflex in the eyes. Even there was no heart beats. In the initial check up it self I got confirmed he was no more. But to avoid that if the same is informed instantly as his wife may take it as shock after examining thoroughly informed her that he appears to be died. However you can take him to the higher center for further examination.

3. Witness further deposed that, at the time of examination the tongue of the deceased was protruded. Witness deposed that in a case of heart attack also some time the tongue of the deceased may protrudes.

4. In connection with this case two to three months after I examined the late Santosh Padmannvar, the Malmaruti police have called me for enquiry wherein I gave my statement as deposed above. At the time of enquiry the police have asked the question whether at the time of examining the Santosh Padmannvar did you had any suspects. But I answered to them that, I didn't noticed any symptoms at that time to suspect on his death.

5. After informing the fact of death of her husband I did not noticed any extreme grief or sorrow-ness in her face. Witness further volunteers that I noticed only little sadness.

Cross Examination by Sri. RCP Advocate for accused No.1 to 5:

Shri. CYM for the RCP is present submits that he has no cross to this witness.
