

Counsel Sri.KAM for appellant is present and files memo seeking extension of time and heard on memo.

Orders on Memo filed on behalf of the Appellant

The counsel for appellant has filed memo stating that the appellant has not complied the order of this court due to his financial difficulties and due to his ill health and prayed that stay kindly be extended for one week for compliance.

On perusal it can be seen that in this case this court has granted stay to the proceedings and Judgment and in the memo filed by the appellant it is mentioned that in spite of diligent efforts made by them, they could not secure the amount to deposit 10% before the trial court. Now the appellant intends to pay the amount and appellant is seeking that time may be granted to him to deposit the amount before the trial court, in the interest of justice.

2. Having heard the appellant and on

perusal of the order of this court dated 29.11.2025, further time can be granted at this juncture to meet the ends of justice.

3. In view of the above, memo is allowed and further time is granted. The appellant/accused shall deposit 10% of the fine amount before the Trial Court and to execute personal bond for Rs.50,000/- with a surety for like sum to the satisfaction of the Trial Court **within 15 days from the date of this order, i.e. 19.01.2026.**
