ORDERS ON I.A. IV

The instant I.A. IV is filed by the plaintiff seeking to get the original agreement of sale marked in evidence. The said application is accompanied with the memo of facts

wherein it is stated that the said document is important to establish that the suit property is the joint family property and therefore it is necessary to get the said document marked in evidence. The Learned advocate for the defendants 1 to 4 has placed objection to the said I.A. wherein the denied that the suit property is a joint family property and further contended that the said property is the self acquired property of defendant No.1. Further it is contended as the said document is an un registered document, the same can not be taken up for marking. Hence prays for rejection of the said I.A.

Heard. Perused. After due perusal of the materials placed on records, the Court opines that considering the stage of the suit and the reasons assigned in the said I.A. and further considering that in the document is only an agreement of sale and if the same is allowed to be marked subject to objection, it would be in the ends of justice. Hence the following:
