ORDER

(Delivered on 10th day of July, 2026)

1. This Order shall dispose of the application under section 24 C.P.C. read with section 237 of Motor Vehicle Act, filed by the applicants.
2. Records of the concerned court were received.
3. Applicants has moved an application u/s 24 C.P.C. read with section 237 of Motor Vehicle Act pleaded that MACC No. 966/2025 (Mangal Singh and others Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others) is pending in the Court of the VIIIth MACT, Gwalior and

another MACC No. 1740/2025 (Anshu Singh Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others), MACC No. 1741/2025 (Ajay Kumar Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others) and MACC No. 1742/2025 (Manju Devi Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others) are pending in the Court of IVth MACT, Gwalior. All Cases have arisen out of one and the same accident, all cases are required to be tried by a single tribunal. In view of this, it has been prayed that all cases be transferred to one tribunal to avoid different findings and award by different tribunals.

4. Ld. Counsels Shri Shivakant Dubey and Shri Ramvilash Sharma for the non-applicants, do not want to file a reply and also submitted that they have no objection, if all cases are transferred to one and same tribunal in order to avoid different findings and award by different tribunals.

5. **Point of consideration is :-**

Whether application filed by applicants u/s 24 C.P.C. and r/w section 237 of Motor Vehicle Act, is liable to be allowed?

6. I have gone through the record of all cases MACC No. 966/2025 (Mangal Singh and others Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others), pending in the Court of VIIIth MACT Gwalior and this cases is pending at the stage of filing W.S. and another MACC No. 1740/2025 (Anshu Singh Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others), MACC No. 1741/2025(Ajay Kumar Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others) and MACC No. 1742/2025 (Manju Devi Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others), pending in the court of IVth MACT, Gwalior and all cases are pending at the stage of filing of W.S.. From the perusal of the records, it appears that all claim cases are related with same date of incident i.e. 16-05-2025 and in all cases non-applicants are also same. **So, as the all cases are pertain regarding the same date of incident and non-applicants are also same, so it is just to avoid to conflict of decision/findings, it will be appropriate that all cases shall be tried by the same tribunal.**

7. In the result thereof, the transfer application u/s 24 of C.P.C. r/w section 237 of Motor Vehicle Act, filed by applicants is **allowed** and **MACC/966/2025 (Mangal Singh and others Vs. Sudeep Kumar and others)**, pending in the Court of VIIIth MACT Gwalior is withdrawn from that court and is transferred to the Court of IVth MACT Gwalior.

Accordingly, this application is disposed off.

Records of all the cases be sent back to the concerned court.

A copy of order be sent to both courts for compliance.
