File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu.**

Reply to the above said application has been filed by IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that wife of applicant/accused is diagnosed with a calculus in her right kidney of about 5 mm in her lower calyx and a calculus of about 17 mm in her right renal pelvis with upstream mild hydroureteronephrosis. It is further submitted that wife of applicant/accused is opined intensive care, precaution and immediate treatment to be taken for her well being. It is further submitted that presence of applicant/accused is required for taking proper care of his wife and also to make financial arrangements for proper treatment of his wife. It is further submitted that medical documents of wife of applicant/accused are annexed with the application. It is further submitted that no

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application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Special PP for State strongly opposed the present interim bail application and it is argued that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is argued that the surgery of wife of applicant/accused can be performed in day care and as such there is no requirement for getting admitted in the hospital even for a single day. It is argued that there are other family members including mother of applicant/accused, wife of brother of applicant/accused and the family members of applicant/accused etc. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

The present interim bail application has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu** on the ground of illness of his wife. As per the reply filed by IO, there are various family members of applicant/accused who can look after the wife of applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu**. Further,

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applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu** is an accused in MCOC case and he is also involved in multiple criminal cases in past. Possibility of committing similar offence, if he is released on bail cannot be ruled out. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail to applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu**. Interim bail application is dismissed accordingly.

Keeping in view of the above discussion, this Court is not inclined to allow the present interim bail application filed on behalf of applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu**. Same is dismissed accordingly.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. Copy of order be given dasti to the applicant/accused. The present interim bail application along with the proceedings be tagged with the main case file.
