Relief: A decree be passed directing the defts, their agents, servants, henchmen or anybody acting on their behalf may be restrained permanently from obstructing the lawful possession, use and enjoyment of the suit of the plffs and directing the defts, their agents, servants henchmen or anybody acting on their behalf may be restrained permanently from alienating or creating the charge over the suit property of the plffs.

ORDER ON I.A.NO.12

The counsel for plaintiffs filed this application under order VII Rule 14 of CPC seeking permission to produce the documents.

2. On the other hand counsel for defendant has not filed any objections to the said application.

3. Heard and perused the materials available on record.

4. It is submitted by the plaintiff that, he has filed the present suit for permanent injunction and the said suit is now posted for hearing on IA.No.8. It is stated that, after filing the suit, he has also filed a suit at OS.No.234/2014 before the IV Addl Civil Judge, Belagavi for declaration and permanent injunction against the present defendants. It is further stated that, in view of the order passed on 30.04.2014, the said suit has been transferred to this court on the ground that, the subject matter of both the suit is one and the same and between the same parties. It is further stated that, the defendants have appeared and filed their written statement. It is stated that, to prove the fact, he is producing certified copy of the plaint, written statement and ordersheet in respect of OS.No.234/2014. Among the above reasons, prayed to allow the application.

On perusal of the material available on record, it appears that the plaintiff has filed the present suit for the relief of permanent injunction and the plaintiff has filed the application seeking permission to produce the said document. On perusal of the annexed document is the certified copy of the plaint, written statement and ordersheet in respect of OS.NO.234/2014. If the application is allowed, no injury will be caused to the defendants. **Hence I proceed to pass the following,**

ORDER

I.A.No.12 filed by the plaintiff Under order 7 Rule 14 of CPC is hereby allowed on costs of Rs.200/-.

Hence, the plaintiff is permitted to produce the said documents, subject to proof, relevancy admissibility.
