File taken up today on second application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu**.

Reply to the above said application has been filed by IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that wife of applicant/accused is suffering from serious health issues including kidney stone and require proper care, medical attention and assistance, which is presently not available due to the absence of applicant/accused. It is further submitted that applicant/accused has three minor children I.e a daughter aged about 7 years, a son aged about 4 years whose school admission process is ongoing and the school requires mandatory presence of both parents for the interview, failing which admission may be denied. It is further submitted that family of the applicant/accused is facing severe financial hardship as all earning members are in custody. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any

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other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

The present interim bail application has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu** on the ground of admission of minor child in school. As per reply of IO, presence of parent is sufficient, both parents are not required to be present at a time of admission. Further, other family members are also available to complete the admission formalities of the child. No ground for grant of interim bail is made out. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail to applicant/accused **Sanjay Singh @ Sonu**. Interim bail application is dismissed accordingly.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. Copy of order be given dasti to

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the applicant/accused. The present interim bail application along with the proceedings be tagged with the main case file.
