

Case called before the Lok-Adalath.

The learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for respondent/s are present. Both parties are present. Conciliation is held.

Both petitioner and respondent-official have filed a joint memo/ compromise petition stating that, the respondent has agreed to enter the date of birth as claimed in the petition. The learned counsel for petitioner has identified the signatures of the parties and prayed to allow the compromise petition.

Heard and perused the records. As per the **School record** produced by the petitioner, the date of birth mentioned in the said document and date of birth claimed by the petitioner are tallied with each other. Both parties have filed a joint memo / compromise petition and matter is settled between the parties. The respondent has agreed to enter the date of birth as claimed in the petition. Hence, we find that, the compromise petition filed by both parties is voluntary, lawful and bonafide. Hence, in the interest of justice, we proceed to pass following.

### **ORDER**

Joint memo/Compromise petition filed before Lok Adalath by both parties is hereby allowed. The respondent is directed to enter the date of birth of **Lakhan Shrishail Naik** as **08.10.2009** at **Gundewadi village of Athani taluk** in the concerned birth register and issue Birth

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Certificate to the petitioner subject to payment of prescribed fee as per law.
