ORDER

Advocate Prashant Pandey a/w Dinesh Jadhvani i/b W3 Legal LLP applicant present. Application is filed for interim bail for performing rites pinddan and antim bhajan of the brother. Ld APP filed say and opposed the

application. Heard the both parties. The accused is charge-sheet for the offence punishable u/s 316(2), 318(4), 111(2)(b), 111(3), 111(4), 111(6), 111(7), 3(5), of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, under Section 66 (c) of the Information Technology Act, and Section 25 (c) of the Indian Telegraph Act. Ld advocate for the applicant submitted that the brother of the accused has committed suicide and applicant is the only male member in his house. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submitted that the bail application of the applicant accused is rejected by the Hon'ble High Court. However, in the circumstances the applicant accused be granted interim bail for performing above mentioned rites of his brother. Considering the submissions and in the circumstances the applicant accused is granted interim bail for the period from 27.12.2025 to 02.01.2026 performing pinddan, antim bhajan and other rites for his brother on following condition:

The applicant accused Amir Sanjay Kas Reddy (अमिर संजय कास रेड्डी) arrested in CR no.13/2025 registered with DCB CID unit 12 Mumbai for the offence punishable u/s 316(2), 318(4), 111(2)(b), 111(3), 111(4), 111(6), 111(7), 3(5), of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, under Section 66 (c) of the Information Technology Act and Section 25 (c) of the Indian Telegraph Act, be released on interim bail on his executing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with surety in like amount subject to following conditions -

- a) Interim bail is granted to the applicant accused from 6.00 pm of 27.12.2025 till 6.00 pm of 02.01.2025.
- b) He shall mark his presence before the respondent as and when called under written intimation.

c) He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.

d) He shall surrender before the DCB CID unit 12 Mumbai (respondent) at 6.00 pm on 02.01.2026 without fail for shifting him to Arthur Road Central Jail.

e) He shall not indulge himself in any criminal activity during the interim bail tenure.

f) He shall furnish his residential address and contact details to the respondent and immediately after his release.

iii] Provisional cash bail in lieu of surety stands granted for a period of one day. The cash Bail be accepted after Treasury hours.

Iv] In case of breach of any of the above condition, the prosecution is at liberty to move the Court for cancellation of bail. Interim Bail Application Exhibit 18 is disposed of accordingly.
