COMMON ORDER ON
IA Nos.26 AND 27

IA No.26 is filed by the defendant Nos.1, 3 and 4 under Section 151 of C.P.C., seeking permission to file additional objections to IA No.25.

In the affidavit filed in support of the said application defendant No.3 stated that due to being engaged in the agricultural work, he could not file objections earlier and therefore seeks to leave the place additional objections on record.

IA No.27 is filed by the defendant Nos.11 to 17 under Section 151 of C.P.C., seeking permission to file additional objections to IA No.25.

In the affidavit in support of the said application, defendant No.15 has stated that certain important facts were inadvertently left

out in the objections already filed and hence the permission is sought to file additional objections.

The plaintiff has not filed any objection to either of the applications.

The learned counsel for plaintiff has fairly submitted before this court that he has no objection for allowing the IA No.27.

Considering the reasons assigned in the affidavits filed in support of IA Nos.26 and 27 and in the absence of opposition from the plaintiff this court is of the view that no prejudice would be caused to the plaintiff if the defendants are permitted to file additional objections to IA No.25. On the contrary, such permission would aid the court in effectively adjudicating upon the IA No.25 after having benefit of complete pleadings from both sides. So, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

IA No.26 filed by the defendant Nos.1, 3 and 4 and IA No.27 filed by the defendant Nos. 11 to 17 under Section 151 of C.P.C., are hereby allowed on cost of Rs.200/ each.

The defendant Nos.1, 3, 4 as well as defendant Nos.11 to 17 are permitted to file their additional objections to IA No.25, subject to payment of cost.
