JUDGMENT

(Pronounced on 28th July, 2026)

This is an application under Section 372 of Indian Succession Act.

02] Briefly stated, the case of the applicant is that, she is only legal heir of deceased Prabhakar Nagesh Divekar and Suneeta Prabhakar Divekar who died on 23/11/2021 and 22/04/2024 respectively. Deceased Prabhakar Nagesh Divekar died intestate leaving behind an amount of Rs. 2,98,153/- in saving account no. 11062486202 in State Bank of India, Amravati branch and an amount of Rs. 6,00,372/- in pension account no. 11062486213 in State Bank of India, Amravati branch. Being only legal heir, she is entitled to collect those amounts. For that purpose, she requires succession certificate. Hence, she has filed present application for grant of succession certificate.

03] A public notice and citation was issued upon filing of the application. However, no objection whatsoever is received pursuant to public notice and citation issued by this Court.

04] Following points arise for my determination and I have recorded my findings thereon for the reasons given below:

<u>Sr. No</u>	<u>POINTS</u>	<u>FINDINGS</u>
01.	Whether applicant is legal heir of deceased Prabhakar Nagesh Divekar ?	<u>Yes.</u>
02.	Whether applicant is entitled to get succession certificate in her name?	<u>Yes.</u>
03.	What order?	Application is allowed.

REASONS

As to Point Nos. 1 to 3 :-

05] To substantiate the contention, applicant stepped into witness box and filed affidavit of evidence at Exh.10. Averments made in the application are reiterated in affidavit of evidence.

To support oral evidence, the applicant has produced documentary evidence viz. death certificates (Exh.13 and Exh. 14), sale deed (Exh.15), passbook (Exh.16), letter dated 03/07/2025 (Exh.17), balance amount certificate (Exh.18), pan card (Exh.19), aadhar card (Exh.20) and letter dated 06/08/2025 (Exh.21). These documentary evidence supports the claim made by applicant.

06] Apart from this, no objection whatsoever is received pursuant to public notice and citation. As such, I do not find any reason to reject the evidence adduced by applicant. Thus, applicant is the only legal heir of deceased Prabhakar Nagesh Divekar and she is entitled to get succession certificate as per Section 372 of Indian Succession Act.

07] For these reasons, I have recorded my findings to point no. 1 to 3 accordingly. In the result, following order is passed:

ORDER

<u>ORDER</u>	
1.	Application is allowed.
2.	Issue succession certificate in the name of applicant as per Section 372 of Indian Succession Act, upon payment of requisite fees as per rules.
3.	It is made clear that, succession certificate is issued in respect of amount mentioned in application only and not for any other purpose.
