JUDGMENT

(Pronounced on 17th July, 2026)

This is an application under Section 372 of Indian Succession Act.

02] Breifly stated, the case of applicants is that they are only legal heirs of deceased Pramod Vitthal Advant, who died on 21/08/2025. Deceased Pramod Vitthal Advant died intestate leaving behind an amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- in fixed deposit A/c No. 050343710000816. An amount of Rs. 7,52,702.31/- in saving A/c No. 050310100001492. After demise of Pramod Vitthal Advant, applicants are entitled to get the said amount. For that purpose, they require succession certificate. Hence, they have filed this application for grant of succession certificate.

03] A public notice and citation was issued upon filing of the application. However, no objection whatsoever is received pursuant to public

notice and citation issued by this Court.

04] Following points arise for my determination and I have recorded my findings thereon for the reasons given below:

01.	Whether applicants are legal heirs of deceased Pramod Vitthal Advant ?	<u>Yes.</u>
02.	Whether applicants are entitled to get succession certificate?	<u>Yes.</u>
03.	What order?	Application is allowed.

REASONS

As to Point Nos. 1 to 3 :-

05] To substantiate the contention, applicant No.1 stepped into witness box and filed affidavit of evidence at Exh.9. All averments made in the application are reiterated in her affidavit of evidence. To support oral evidence, the applicants

have produced documentary evidence viz. aadhar card of Pramod Vitthal Advant (Exh. 11), death certificate of Pramod Vitthal Advant (Exh.12), aadhar cards (Exh. 13 and 14), FD receipt (Exh. 15), passbook (Exh. 16) and light bill (Exh. 17). These documentary evidence supports the claim of the applicants.

06] No objection whatsoever is received pursuant to public notice and citation. As such, I do not find any reason to reject the evidence adduced by applicants. Thus, I hold that applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Pramod Vitthal Advant and they are entitled to get succession certificate as per Section 372 of Indian Succession Act. For these reasons, I have recorded my findings to point no. 1 to 3 accordingly. In the result, following order is passed:

<u>ORDER</u>	
1.	Application is allowed.
2.	Issue succession certificate in the name of applicants No.1 to 3 as per Section 372 of Indian Succession Act, upon payment of requisite fees

	as per rules.
3.	It is made clear that, succession is issued in respect of amount mentioned in application only and not for any other purpose.
