2. Whether the plaintiff further proves that himself and Defendants are the members of Hindu Undivided Family and the suit properties are their ancestral joint family properties ?
3. Whether the Plaintiff further proves that he is having share in the $\frac{1}{4}$ share of Defendant no. 4 ?
4. Whether the Defendant no. 1 to 3 prove that they are the only surviving legal heirs of deceased Ningappa?
5. Whether the Plaintiff further proves that gift deed dated 13-09-2023 executed by deceased Ningappa in respect of Sy. No. 149/3 in favour of Defendant no. 1 to 3 is not binding on his share in the suit properties ?
6. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the relief sought for ?

7. What order or decree ?
