2. Whether the plaintiffs further prove that they are having 1/5 share each in the suit properties ?
3. Whether the Plaintiffs further prove that registered partition deed bearing document no. BLG-1-03073-2018-19 dated 31-10-2018 and registered sale deed bearing document no. BLG-1-00507-2020-21 are not binding on them ?
4. Whether the Defendant no. 3 proves that the suit properties are the self acquired properties of Defendant no. 1 & 2 as contended in para no. 7 of his written statement ?

5. Whether the Defendant no. 3 further proves that the Plaintiffs have relinquished their rights in the suit properties in favour of Defendant no. 1 & 2, as such, they es-stopped from seeking partition ?
6. Whether the Defendant no. 3 further proves that the Defendant no. 1 acquired schedule B property in registered partition deed dated 31-10-2018 effected between Defendant no. 1 & 2 ?
7. Whether the Defendant no. 3 further proves that he has purchased schedule B property under registered sale deed for valuable consideration ?
8. Whether the Defendant no. 3 proves that the suit of the Plaintiff is barred by limitation ?
9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the relief sought for ?
10. What order or decree ?
