ORDER ON IA No.3

The plaintiff has filed the present application under Order VI Rule 17 R/w. Sec. 151 of CPC seeking permission to amend the plaint by inserting the correct name of defendant No.4, adding additional Paragraph No.5(a) and 5(b) explaining the status of the plaintiff and defendant No.12 and deleting the first line of the paragraph No.7 of the plaint referring to defendant Nos.9 to 11 and inserting to defendant Nos.9 to 12 in its place.

In the affidavit filed in support of the application, it is stated that due to oversight the name of defendant No.4 was wrongly mentioned as Kasturewwa W/o Padmappa Kyatanavar and correct name is Kasturewwa W/ Padmappa Kalagoudra. It is further stated that serial numbers of the defendants were wrongly mentioned in Paragraph No.7 and 10 of the plaint and

that the status of the plaintiff and defendant Nos.12 to 14 was not properly explained due to inadvertent. Hence the amendment has been sought.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the defendants has submitted that he has no objection for allowing the application.

I have perused the application, affidavit and records.

The amendments sought are formally in nature and are intended to bring pleadings in the conformity of the correct particulars. Hence no prejudice will be caused to the defendants. The defendants themselves have expressed no objection to the proposed amendment. The proposed amendment are necessary for the proper adjudication of the matter. Accordingly, the application deserves to be allowed. So, this court deems it fit to pass the following;

ORDER

IA No.3 filed by the plaintiff U/o.VI
Rule 17 R/w. Sec. 151 of C.P.C., is
hereby allowed.

The plaintiff is permitted to carry
out the amendment to the plaint.
