The plaintiff and defendants are present along with their respective learned counsel. They have filed a joint compromise petition under Order 23 Rule 3 of C.P.C.

The contents of the compromise petition are read over and explained to both the parties in a language known to them. They admit the contents thereof as true and correct and also admit their respective signatures appearing on the compromise petition.

The terms of the compromise have been carefully perused. We, the conciliators, are satisfied that the compromise arrayed at between parties is lawful, voluntarily and not opposed to any provision of law on public policy.

Accordingly, the matter is settled before the Lok Adlat. The suit is

disposed of in terms of compromise petition. The compromise petition shall form part of the award.

Draw the award/decreed accordingly and remit the records to the regular court.
