Ans. :- Yes.

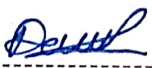
Q.2. :- Have you understood the particular read over and explained to you?

1. Accused stand presented for the offence U/sec. 285 of B.N.S. 2023. The particulars of the offence read over and explained to the accused. The accused pleaded guilty for the same by application and prayed for mercy.
2. The only question therefore arise for me -
 - (I) Whether the accused pleaded guilty voluntarily ? Yes
 - (ii) Whether the leniency be shown to him ? Yes
3. I Answered these points in the affirmative for the reasons stated below.

REASONS

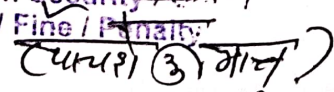
1) Accused pleaded guilty. Considering the nature of offence and plea of the accused. I found that the plea is voluntarily made. Accused is repenting his act. Hence, prayed for leniency while passing sentence. Thus, considering facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offence, I have taken lenient view, I am opinion that, Imposing fine would be sufficient punishment for the accused. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) The accused **Daud Shamsher Shah** is convicted under Section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for the offence punishable under section 285 of BNS, 2023.
- 2) Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- (Rs. Five Hundred only), in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for 01 day.
