P L E A

It is alleged against you that on 15.10.2023 you issued the cheque bearing No.687530 for Rs.50,000/- drawn on Indian Overseas Bank, Ankali branch, infavour of the complainant in respect of legally recoverable debt owed towards complainant. When the said cheque was presented to Canara Bank, Ankali branch dated 04.11.2023, the same dishonoured for the reason "Funds Insufficient" as per endorsement of banker dated 06-11-2023. As per the request of accused again on 28-11-2023

the complainant presented the said cheque in Canara Bank, the same also dishonoured for the reason "Funds Insufficient" as per endorsement of banker dated 30-11-2023. Thereafter, the complainant issued the legal notice dated 28.12.2023, which was served on you. In spite of it, you have failed to make the payment of cheque amount within stipulated period and your such act amounts to offence punishable U/Sec.138 of the N.I. Act and within my cognizance.

I hereby direct you to be tried for the above said offence.
