

Dharam Singh Vs. Baljit Kumar etc.

Present:- Complainant with counsel Sh. R.K. Koundal, Advocate.

Today the case was fixed for the consideration on cancellation report presented by the police. Heard. Perusal of the file transpires that cancellation report has been presented by the police in the instant FIR no.249 dated 28.08.2022 u/s 452, 323, 506, 427, 34 IPC, PS City-1, Abohar, by categorically reciting that nothing has come to the surface against accused Vinod Kumar, Munshi Ram and Bagh Chand and the instant FIR is liable to be canceled. In view of these facts and circumstances, the present cancellation report is liable to be accepted.

However, as far as the averments made in the complaint are concerned, the same can be ascertained by leading evidence by applicant/complainant in the court. Accordingly, present complaint be treated as protest petition and the papers of UCR be attached with the same and the same be registered as private petition. Ahlmad is directed to register the present case as complaint case in the CIS system. As per proviso of Section 223 of BNSS 2023, the accused shall be given an opportunity of being heard before taking cognizance of the offences in the instant complaint. In order to provide opportunity of being heard to the accused in the instant complaint before taking cognizance, let, notice to accused be issued through process serving agency, E-mail of accused, whatsapp number of accused, SMS or any other electronic media as well as through BNPL/ speed post or any other service of postal department on payment of requisite charges and other instant messaging services as held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Re-cognizance of Extension of Limitation (Suo Moto Writ Petition Civil No. 3/2000 dated 10.07.2020)* for 07.11.2026. Dasti summons be given if so desired.
