

Sri.SGI Advocate files Vakalath for defendant No.3 along with application U/O. IX Rule 7 of CPC. Ld counsel for plaintiff submitted no objections to allow the application. Hence the application is allowed. Defendant No.3 is permitted to contest the suit by setting aside order passed against her. Ld counsel for plaintiff files memo not pressing the suit against defendant No.1 and 2. Perused, memo is accepted. In view of the same, suit against D1 and 2 is dismissed as not pressed. Plaintiff, defendant No.3 and their respective counsels are present and compromised the matter amicably and filed a compromise petition under order XXIII Rule 3 R/w Sec.151 of CPC along with photostat copies of Aadhaar cards. Perused the same and the contents of the compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties in the language known to them and they have agreed and accepted the same. Compromise seems to be lawful and voluntary one. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following; ORDER The compromise petition is accepted and the suit of the plaintiff is decreed in terms of the compromise petition. Office to draw decree accordingly. The compromise petition shall be the part and parcel of the decree.
