Further, the Defendant No.10 and 11 have submitted that they have already received 02 tola Gold each from the Defendant No.8, 12 and 13 and relinquished their share over suit schedule properties in favour of Defendant No.8, 12 and 13, to that effect they have executed separate receipt.

The contents of the compromise petition are not oppose to law and public policy and on enquiry it is found that the compromise is voluntarily entered in between both the parties. Hence, the compromise is accepted.

Office is directed to draw Final Decree as per the terms and conditions of the compromise petition.

In the compromise petition there is no any over-writings are made or any matter is substituted or deleted.

Further the plaintiff No.1 to 5 and defendant No.1 to 14 submitted that, as per the compromised entered in between them they are in possessions their respective shares and their they will not file any petition for recovery of their shares.
