1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that themselves and defendant No.1 to 10 constitute joint Hindu undivided family and suit properties are their ancestral and joint family properties and available for partition ?
2. Whether the defendant No.8 and 9 prove that there was already partition between deceased Bhimappa and Balappa in the year 1993 i.e., 10.08.1993 ?
3. Whether the defendant No.8, 9, 14 and 15 prove that the partition between deceased Bhimappa and Balappa in O.S.No.194/2003 and suit is hit by principles of res-judicate ?

4. Whether the defendant No.8 and 9 prove that suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties and mis-joinder of parties ?
5. Whether the defendant No.8 and 9 prove that suit is not maintainable for non-inclusion all family properties belongs to plaintiffs and defendant No.1 to 4 ?
6. Whether the defendant No.14 and 15 prove that they are bonafide purchaser of suit properties ?
7. Whether the defendant No.14 and 15 prove that suit is barred by law of limitation ?
8. Whether the plaintiffs entitled share in the suit properties as sought for ?
9. What order or decree ?
